Doing a doctorate at TU Dresden



Doctorates are administered by the 18 faculties of TU Dresden

- Doctoral Regulations, Doctoral Admission Board, Doctoral Office
- Registration as a doctoral candidate
- Submission of the doctoral thesis
- Organization and execution of the oral exam and the defense of the doctoral thesis
- Award of the doctoral degree





Graduate Academy | Objectives




- Fostering an excellent, internationally-orientated academic culture at TU Dresden

Structure of the Graduate Academy








Graduate Academy | Membership

Membership is free of charge Voluntary membership upon application:

- Doctoral candidate
 accepted by one of TU Dresden's Faculties
- Supervisor
 at least one of his/her supervised doctoral candidates
 must be member of the Graduate Academy
- Postdoc employment/scholarship at TU Dresden
- Associated membership
 - doctoral candidates and postdocs engaged in collaborative projects with the TU Dresden, i.e. joint doctoral programs
 - postdocs more than six years after the conclusion of their doctorate

Offers | Funding: Lab to Lab

Aim of the program:

 Promotion of the exchange and joint cooperation of young scientists on the basis of international cooperation between working groups (AGs).

Extent of funding:

max. EUR 10,000 (duration: 18 months)

Type of funding:

- Mandatory module: research stay of a doctoral candidate or postdoc of the TU Dresden in the working group abroad
- Flexible modules:
 - ✓ Research stays of further doctoral candidates and/or postdocs of the participating working groups (incoming and outgoing)
 - ✓ Joint meetings of the partner groups, organized by the involved early career researches, at TU Dresden or abroad

- The spokespersons are appointed by the Rectorate as a voting members of the GA Executive Committee.


