- Frequent invitations for panel discussions and workshops in ERASMUS+ and HORIZON related events on national and international level








# **Role in HERD**


# R&D Seasonal School |1

- Project controlling concerning deadlines and budget









#### **Recommendations and ideas for future**

- Look for solutions that suit your environment, don't just copy from anywhere

- Discuss regional networks to boost infrastructure logistics
- Involve stakeholders, i.e. the local governments, city councils etc
- $\rightarrow$  be open, think bigger, go beyond existing patterns
